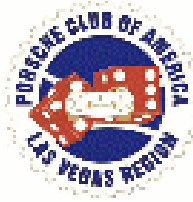

The meeting was called to order at 6:30pm.

## **Old Business**

The August 2006 meeting minutes were reviewed by T Zito along with the August 2006 Treasurer's Report being reviewed by R Gabe. A motion to accept both the minutes and the treasurer's report was made by R LaSpada and was seconded by J Burrows.

## **New Business**
